Florida Organic Growers and Consumers, Inc. has enrolled the above named entity in a project committed to assisting Florida farmers transition to organic production. The above named entity has adopted agricultural production methods consistent with organic agriculture and is in the process of the mandatory 3-year transition period in order for land to be eligible for organic certification. To be recognized as a transitional farm, the grower has attested that no materials prohibited in organic agriculture have been applied to land during the previous 12 months; that in the case of crops that require a maturation period of greater than 12 months, the produce represented as transitional has not received prohibited inputs during the entire maturation period; and has committed to have all agricultural inputs, including fertility amendments, and pest and disease control products reviewed by FOG to verify compliance to organic standards. In addition, the above named grower has been provided a copy of the National Organic Program (NOP) regulations that govern the production, handling and marketing of organic agricultural products and has signed a pledge in good faith to uphold organic farming standards and to not misuse recognition as a transitional grower or to misrepresent as transitional any product which is not to the best of their knowledge produced in accordance with organic standards. This document in no way confers organic status to land/crops managed/produced by the above named entity.
